

ISCCW SPECIAL BOARD MEETING  
SEPTEMBER 30, 2011 – Approved Minutes  
USFS CONFERENCE ROOM

DIRECTORS AND OFFICERS PRESENT: President Dudley Pierce, Vice President Ken Wendt, Secretary Ruth Bozdech, Steve Wilkinson, Renee Shurr, Margie Marrs, Joe LoMastro, Jim Floriano, Fred Duerkop and Will Buergey.

SPECIAL GUEST; Barb Gajewski

President Dudley Pierce called the meeting to order at 9:05 AM.

Dudley asked Barb to tell the board of her findings in Bass Lake in September.

Barb reported Bass Lake was 80% covered with EWM in 2010. She did 280 points in the lake to obtain the following information.

1. The average depth of Bass Lake is 9 feet.
2. The amount of EWM found in Sept. was 3% to 5%.
3. Secchi readings have been poor.
4. Phosphorus readings are low.
5. Barb's conclusion is something has been introduced into the lake to cause the EWM to die.
6. Water samples were sent to a lab for analysis to determine if and what chemical might have been introduced to the lake with negative results.

A long discussion followed concerning the possibility of not going forward with the planned fluridone treatment next spring. Other concerns were expressed, contamination, illegal treatment and ramifications to the ISCCW.

The decision was made to formally notify DEQ of the findings in Bass Lake.

Will Buergey made a motion to table any further action until the regular ISCCW board meeting. Ken Wendt added to the motion saying he would send a letter to DEQ advising them of the ISCCW findings in Bass Lake, seconded by Steve Wilkinson, and approved.

Motion to adjourn was made by Joe LoMastro, seconded by Will Buergey and approved.
